



Rules of Play

U.S.G.A. rules govern all play except where modified by local rules.

Local Rules

- Pace of play: Players must realize that for each hole they fail to keep pace adds 15 minutes to every group behind.
- Pace of play: Players falling one and one half holes behind will be required to pick up and proceed to the next tee.
- 3. On Holes #3 and 4 If your tee shot goes into the hazard, please proceed to the drop area on the other side for your next shot.
- 4. Do Not wave players up on par 3's.
- 5. Yellow stakes define water hazards. Red stakes define lateral water hazards.
- 6. All players are required to wear appropriate golfing attire at all times.
- 7. Observe cart path rules and all ropes.
- 8. Do not litter. Please use receptacles.
- 9. Twosomes and singles will be paired.
- 10. Observe proper golf etiquette. Be as considerate to the group behind you as you would like the one in front to be to you.
- 11. Coolers are not allowed.
- 12. Out-of-bounds are designated by fences on Holes # 4, 6, 7 and 16.
- 13. Be extremely careful with golf carts. Drivers must be at least 16 years of age to operate carts.
- 14. Lightning. Play at own risk. Golfers are advised to evacuate at first sign of lightning.
- 15. Sand areas in front of 5th tee, and between Holes # 12 and 14, are considered waste areas.
